Notice of Monthly Service Fee Increase

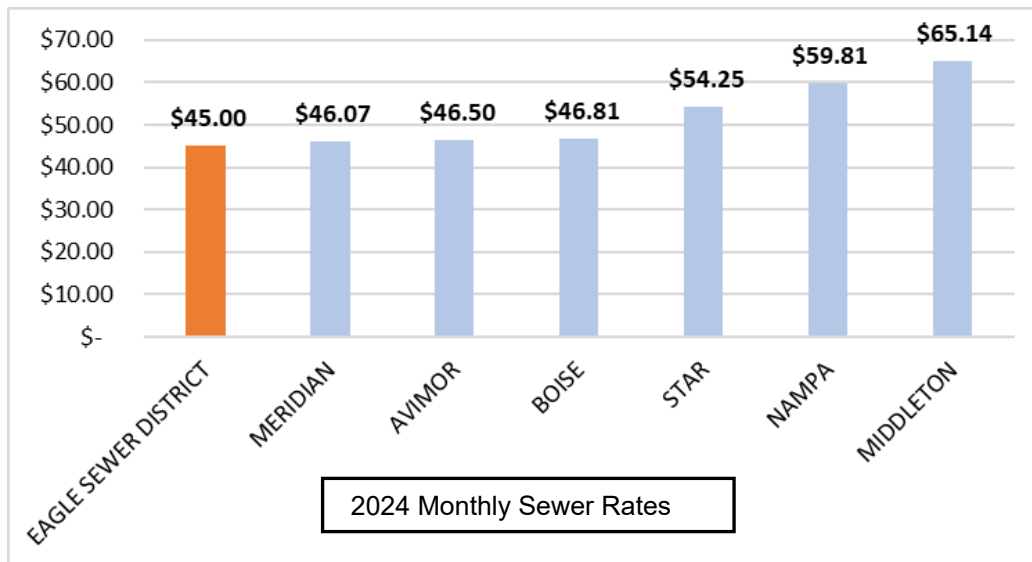
Eagle Sewer District is your central sewer service provider for the Eagle area. We collect the used water from homes and businesses and clean it up most of the way before the water receives its final cleaning at the City of Boise and is released to the Boise River.

We appreciate the feedback we received during our recent 20-year planning effort. We heard from our patrons that they want us to invest in water cleaning processes at the District to reduce the Boise water cleaning cost. It was also said that in the near future they want us to make irrigation quality water. This water is drought-proof and will help bolster irrigation canal water supplies. We are moving forward with the strategic infrastructure investments in the plan to keep water collection and cleaning rates low while moving towards reusing the water for irrigation.

River vs Irrigation Water Quality
 -The main differences between river water quality and irrigation water are the fertilizer (nitrogen and phosphorus) levels and disinfection (virus and pathogen removal) levels.
 - River: remove more fertilizer, less disinfection.
 - Irrigation: remove less fertilizer, more disinfection.

Effective June 1, 2024, Eagle Sewer District’s monthly service fee has been increased from \$39 per month to \$45 per month for each equivalent residential connection.

Commercial customers and multiple residential units will see their monthly bill increased accordingly. The District’s Board of Directors implemented the fee increase at the Public Hearing held on May 13, 2024.
